RSA - Responsible Service of Alcohol

This course is designed to cover the skills and knowledge required to responsibly sell or serve alcohol and to satisfy the requirements for responsible sale and service of alcohol under State or Territory legislation.

This course covers the RSA skills and knowledge requirements common to New South Wales.



This RSA training course involves the successful completion of the unit [SITHFAB009A - Provide responsible Service of Alcohol](#) from the Tourism, Hospitality & Events Training Package SIT07.

This course is recognised under the Australian Quality Training Framework and satisfies all requirements of the NSW Casino, Liquor & Gaming Control Authority for those wishing to work in the NSW hospitality industry.

Course Content
